- It is an advantage that all candidates have an appropriate amount of professional experience within the Wine & Beverages industry.
- Each Unit has a set exam date attached. The examinations are on fixed days set globally by the WSET Awards Dept.
- The courses take place between: 09:30 and 18:30 hours (local time).
- PLEASE NOTE that enrolment is only valid for attendance on the set dates listed on the corresponding programmes/modes.

Registration Deadline: 17 January 2025

Prior study is required before commencing courses. Thus, students should book at least 12 (twelve) weeks in ahead of start date. Both courses will be taught by the Award - winning lecturing team of WSPC ("Riedel Trophy of the Best Educator of the year 2009"), while visiting MWs may be an option.
