Crete, the largest Greek island, forms a natural barrier between the Aegean and the Libyan Seas. It is a land where history, culture, and nature come together. Home to the ancient Minoan civilization, the island offers remarkable archaeological sites, traditional villages, and a rich culinary heritage rooted in local ingredients and Cretan cuisine. Its wines are defined by indigenous grape varieties, diverse terroirs, and abundant sunshine, expressing a distinctive Mediterranean identity. Combined with its climate, topography, and natural water resources, these attributes make Crete an exceptional destination for viticulture. Modern winemaking is continually raising quality standards, positioning Crete as one of the Mediterranean's most dynamic and exciting emerging wine regions.

More specifically, the first Block of this special programme will take place in Heraklion, a city on the island of Crete, enhancing the course with an experiential discovery of this region with roots going back to antiquity. Participants will explore local vineyards and wineries, gaining first-hand insight into indigenous grape varieties and traditional winemaking practices that continue to define Crete's evolving wine identity with a strong sense of place.

The rest of the Blocks will be held in Athens, at the brand new and highly impressive and spacious premises of WSPC at Paleo Faliro, an area less than 5km outside the city center. - The courses take place between: 09:30 and 18:30 hours (local time).

Registration Deadline: 15 January 2027

Prior study is required before commencing courses. Thus, students should book at least 12 (twelve) weeks in ahead of start date. Konstantinos has served as a member of the Council of the Institute of Masters of Wine (IMW) for nine years and as Chair of the Trips Committee for ten years.
